



Lawfield Standards & Quality Report 2018-19

Regular tracking & attainment meetings have been held between teachers and management team which include predictions and actions to raise attainment;

Close the Attainment gap - Project Equity:
Improving curriculum, learning, teaching and assessment.

Moderation activities have increased as part of the planning process; All teachers have participated in HT course to develop planning approaches across the school.

Writing: Across the school there has been an overall increase in attainment of 17%.
Numeracy: there has been a 5% increase in attainment across the school.

Raise attainment and achievement
focusing on numeracy and literacy.

In P1, 4 and 7, children from SIMD 1&2 brackets are attaining better than those in SIMD 3+ in both Numeracy & Literacy.

The gender gap in literacy and numeracy has reduced in P7 with boys attaining better. However girls still outperforming boys in P1 and 4.

Exclusions have fallen by 56%.

We have continued to work with our third sector partners and other partner agencies through our Wellbeing Systems and Processes which has improved outcomes for most learners.

Our new Relationships & Behaviour Policy is fully embedded and pupils have fed back positively about its impact.

Improvement in skills for life:
Improve access to and tracking of wider achievement opportunities.

Despite our efforts, attendance has fallen overall by 0.12%. There have been improvements in P1 and P5 attendance. Unfortunately the number of Unauthorised Absences (mainly attributed to families taking holidays during term time) is between 2% and 3% in each year group. This is significantly impacts pupils' attainment.

180 Pupils are signed up to Children's University.

We have worked hard to promote the Aspire journey and this gives us a good tool to track wider achievement as well as skills development regularly.
